<b>Summary of the motion</b>

About half of the SERVAS member countries maintain their host data in Dolphin. To facilitate the development of SOL (Servas Online) and the migration of the existing host data to the future SOL database, all member countries should be encouraged to use dolphin as their member database.

<b>Background information and reasons for proposing the motion.</b>
---

Migration of data is always a difficult and crucial process. The more different sources are to be considered during a migration process, the more difficulties will arise. To support the migration of data to SOL, the data should already be consolidated in advance - and in our opinion - in the existing HOST DOLPHIN system. This matches also the problem mentioned in SERVAS Distant Vote DV Nov2014 motion EXCO-001-2014 of 2014-09-18: "In the context of the developing Servas On Line Project - SOL, each National Secretary of a National Servas Group should create a list of individual members (travelers, host and others) from relevant data bases before March of each year. ...". In our opinion, all member countries using the Dolphin system for their host data should be exempted from the obligation to compile such a list of individual members.
