Summary of the motion

That Servas national groups around the world use the new SI logo

#### Background information and reasons for proposing the motion.

Servas International will have a much better potential to grow in numbers of individual members and member groups if the organisation uses one standardized logotype. Historically there have been numerous logo's which gives a scattered impression of the organisation.

Since 2014 there's a new Servas logo that more than 20 Servas member countries have adopted and are using after the recommendation of SI Exco.
