
Day 1: July 2

Participants will arrive after 16:00 and enjoy a welcome dinner.

Day 2: July 3

The journey begins in Tyniec, where, for nearly a thousand years, Benedictine monks have lived in their picturesque Medieval Abbey perched on a rocky hill above the river. From there, we will cycle along the scenic Vistula River valley towards Kraków, enjoying breathtaking views and discovering many fascinating sites along the way.


Once we reach the city, you will continue on foot with a guided walk through the charming streets of the Old Town. During this part of the tour, you will learn about Kraków's rich and fascinating history while exploring its most important landmarks. After exploring the city we'll set off on a bike ride to our accommodation. The total route is circa 40 km.

Day 3: July 4

On the following day we also plan a cycling route around the Błędów Desert. The Błędów Desert Loop is one of the most fascinating cycling routes in southern Poland. This approximately 25–30 km trail circles the famous Błędów Desert – often called the “Polish Sahara”. It offers a unique experience, combining sandy landscapes, forest trails, and panoramic



Day 4: July 5 (Optional)

On the last day, Sunday, we propose a trip to the Ojców Valley. This will be optional, only for those interested. All the places are reachable from the guesthouse without additional transport.

The Ojcow Valley is one of the most beautiful valleys in Poland, located in the Ojcow National Park near Kraków. It is famous for its picturesque limestone cliffs, caves, and the ruins of a medieval castle in Ojcow. The Prądnik River flows through the valley, creating numerous gorges and springs.

PROGRAM

2-5 July 2026



The activity will be mostly in open air and in natural landscapes. Cycling trips on Friday and Saturday will be about 30 km hilly, some off-road (unpaved roads, more info to follow). A guided walking trip will be possible on Friday and Saturday.

WHEN: 2-5 July 2026 (3 nights, Thu-Sun)

HOW MANY: max 30 participants in shared rooms



ACCOMMODATION: In Agroturystyka Spa and Camping Kluczwoda. Available 4 rooms and 4 studios for 30 people . Additional guests can find accommodation at the campsite, which is part of the lodging complex (own tents) Accommodation with breakfast and evening meal.

MEETING FEES: for 1 person for 3 nights (incl. 3 breakfasts and dinners) +the cost of transporting people and bicycles to the starting point, and the cost of guides around Krakow will be EUR 200/person, (today 1 EUR = 4,25 zł.)

There will be some additional costs for meals, sandwiches and drinks taken on the road. You must be a Servas member to join. Not a member? Get in touch to join!

BIKE RENTING (not included): We are hoping to be able to supply bikes and e-bikes. Let us know if you need a bike when you register!
