Role Overview

Servas Women works to amplify the voices of women and girls, promote human rights, and strengthen leadership opportunities through intercultural exchange, advocacy, and global collaboration.

The Chair ensures alignment with Servas International's mission to build peace through connection, dialogue, and shared understanding across cultures.

Responsibilities

- Strategic leadership and vision for Servas Women
- Program coordination and development for Servas Women's initiatives, including global and regional events, and projects addressing women's rights
- Represent Servas Women at international forums, including the United Nations Commission on the Status of Women (CSW)
- Community engagement and network building
- Governance and communication among Servas Women members
- Leadership development to support women in Servas leadership roles
