

Instructions for the SERVAS Bike Tour in Cartagena-Colombia



Itinerary

We will start the tour in the Getsemani district (or at your hotel, if you have chosen the option with hotel pick-up). During the next two hours we will tour some of the essential corners of Cartagena de Indias, discovering the long history of this coastal city by pedal stroke.

During our bike tour of Cartagena we will get to know its different neighborhoods and visit its port, the most important in Colombia. You will have the opportunity to admire two of its most famous monuments: the sculpture of the old boots and the statue of the Indian woman Catalina.

We will continue our tour observing examples of the city's military architecture, such as the San Felipe Castle or the Pastelillo Fort, a legacy of Cartagena's importance as a colonial port during the Spanish domination.

Finally, the tour will take us through the streets of Getsemani, the oldest neighborhood in Cartagena and the place where the city's independence was declared. During the bike ride we will make stops so you can immortalize your visit to Cartagena de Indias. The tour ends by returning to the starting point.

Hotel pick-up

If you prefer, you can book this tour with pick up and transfer back to your hotel. In that case, we will pick you up before the start of the tour and take you back to your hotel when it is over.
