






4.7	<b>Servas.org Version 2 Update</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● The top level of the Servas group hierarchy is now the Servas group name (Such as Servas Canada), not the country.</li><li>● All countries of the world can be handled</li><li>● Many are grouped together into new top-level Servas Groups</li><li>● It is possible to directly track member groups, vs national or regional groups</li></ul>	Jim presented how the Servas Groups changed for handling country data. The top level of Servas Groups/Region/Subregion is now a “Servas Group”, instead of a single country. Multiple countries can be managed by a single Servas Group.

4.10	<p><b>SI Distant Vote (SI DV) May 2023 (update) (JS, PN)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The discussion about the May-June 2023 SI Distant Vote is going on. There are two major discussion topics:</li> </ul> <p>a) The Servas Ethics Document (current version: December 2022) should not contain two places for names and physical signatures.</p> <p>b) There's a general opinion the wording in one sentence could be phrased in a positive sense (Servas tolerates all ethnical groups, religions et cetera) rather than in a negative (Servas doesn't discriminate).</p> <p>These two issues will, according to the SI Distant Vote Administrator CM, be possible to address in the final SI DV motion and the upcoming voting procedure.</p>	JS and PN will continue to collaborate with SI DVA CM.
